












The Message: The Glory Of God is with us for good!!

2 Thessalonians 3:16 *"Now may* the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord be with you all." Colossians 1:20 "...reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross."

Passover lambs were kept by specially trained shepherds. The lambs were born in this *"tower of the flock"*

The new lambs would even be wrapped in special swaddling clothes once certified.

Jesus was born surrounded by shepherds, set apart to certify the birth of the ultimate Passover Lamb.

Exodus 12:5

"Your lamb shall be without

<u>blemish</u>, a male of the first year." John 1:29

Shepherds:-- social outcasts Jewish Law (Talmud)

- "...not to be witnesses in courts."
- "...no help given to heathen or shepherds."
- Unclean! No access to temple.
- David was a shepherd Illegitimate
- In the right place at the right time.

- 2. God knows where you are and how to reach you
- 3. He speaks your language
- 4. Outcasts became guests of honour
- 5. If you have seen Him you will tell!!!
