

"Satan comes immediately and takes away the word."






4 Basic Forms of Revelation

- 4. **Biblical** Revelation Word




General John 1:3

"For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,..."




Specific

Colossians 1:15 NKJV *"He is <u>the image</u> of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation."*


AMP "[Now] He is <u>the exact</u> <u>likeness</u> of the unseen God [the visible representation of the invisible];"



Spirit John 16:13



John 10:27


"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me." Self-authenticating: When God speaks, His word is innately authenticated by the hearer.


1 John 5:13


Jesus is in the Old Testament concealed:

In the Gospels we see Jesus like a photo graph. Matthew 9:35


"Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people."

- "... God was in Christ reconciling


the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word




2 Corinthians 3:16-19

"It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are <u>spirit, and</u> <u>they are life</u>."




The Bible isn't mainly about you and what you should be doing. It's about God and what He has done.
