

Interesting Facts About Exodus


- Exodus describes the journey of the Israelites from being the forced slaves of Pharaoh to freely choosing to be servants of God. (Ex. 24:3,7).
- There is a parallel between the ark of Noah rescuing humankind and Moses' basket acting as an ark to save the future deliverer. Both point to the atonement to come in Jesus.
- Like Jesus, Moses first makes the pilgrimage out of Egypt and into the presence of God before the people do. Jesus, as firstborn, goes ahead of us and includes us in His relationship with Yahweh (our Father).

General Outline of Exodus¹

- 1:1 15:21 God liberates Israel by defeating Pharaoh
- 15:22 18:27 God journeys with Israel to Mount Sinai
- 19:1 31:18 God established the covenant with Israel
- 32:1 34:35 Israel breaks the covenant, but God re-establishes it
- 35:1 40:38 Israel obeys and God takes up residence with them
