Interesting Facts:

The names of God in the Bible reveal aspects of God's nature and character.

In Ex. 15:26 Yahweh reveals himself to the Israelites for the first time as **YAHWEH-RAPHA** [*yah-way-raw-faw*]: "The Lord Who Heals" (Exodus 15:26) – "I am Jehovah who heals you"

Ex. 17:15 God reveals Himself as **YAHWEH-NISSI** [*yah*-way-nee-*see*]: "The Lord Our Banner."

Fun Facts About the Amalekites:

- *The Amalekites were the first nation to attack Israel in the Bible.
- * Amalek, the first Amalekite, was a direct descendant of Esau, while the Israelites were descendants of Jacob.
- * Israel's first king, Saul, was commanded to destroy the Amalekites and wipe out their stuff. He didn't! He kept their king Agag alive.
- * One of Agag's descendants Haman the Agagite, would later try to wipe out the Israelites in the book of Esther.
- * King Herod who tried to kill baby Jesus had family connections to Esau and the Amalekites.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why do you think grumbling and complaining is such a bad idea? What is God's attitude toward ingratitude?
- 2. Look at 1 Corinthians 10:1-13. What do we learn from Paul and the way in which he used the Old Testament?
- 3. Ex. 15:25 says "So Moses cried out to the Lord for help, and the Lord showed him a piece of wood. Moses threw it into the water, and this made the [bitter] water good to drink." How do you see the cross in this story? What's the lesson here?
- 4. What was God trying to establish in the Israelites through the provision of the manna?
- 5. In Ex. 17:1-7 we see that Moses strikes the rock and water comes gushing out so the people could drink. Look again at 1 Corinthians 10:1-13 and describe how you see Jesus in this story.
- 6. Remembering that Amalek is a type of the flesh, what lessons do we learn from the Israelite battle with the Amalekites? (Ex. 17:8-16)
- 7. What else would you like to talk about from the readings? Do you have any questions?
