"They shall be cities of refuge for you from the avenger, that the manslayer may not die until he stands before the congregation in judge ... These six cities shall be for refuge for the children of Israel, for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them, that anyone who kills a person accidentally may flee there."

"...But after the death of the high priest the manslayer may return to the land of his possession ... no atonement can be made for the land, for the blood that is shed on it, except by the blood of him who shed it. Therefore do not defile the land which you inhabit, in the midst of which I dwell; for I the Lord dwell among the children of Israel.'"
