John 5:45-46 "Yet it isn't I who will accuse you before the Father. Moses will accuse you! Yes, Moses, in whom you put your hopes. If you really believed Moses, you would believe me, because he wrote about me."

Deuteronomy 5:32-33 "So Moses told the people, 'You must <u>be careful to obey all the commands</u> of the Lord your God, following his instructions in every detail. Stay on the path that the Lord your God has commanded you to follow. <u>Then</u> you will live long and prosperous lives in the land you are about to enter and occupy."

Deuteronomy 6:24-25 "And the Lord our God commanded us to obey all these decrees and to fear him so he can continue to bless us and preserve our lives, as he has done to this day. For we will be <u>counted as righteous when we obey all the</u> <u>commands</u> the Lord our God has given us."

Deuteronomy 9:5-6 "...and to fulfill the oath he swore to your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. You must recognize that the Lord your God is <u>not giving you this good land because you are good</u>, for you are not—you are a stubborn people."

Deuteronomy 30:19 "I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, <u>blessing</u> and cursing; therefore <u>choose life</u>, that both you and your descendants may live;"

Deuteronomy 31:28-29 "Now summon all the elders and officials of your tribes, so that I can speak to them directly and call heaven and earth to witness against them. I know that after my death <u>you will become utterly corrupt</u> and will turn from the way I have commanded you to follow."

Deuteronomy 30:6 "The Lord your God will change your heart and the hearts of all your descendants, so that you will love him with all your heart and soul and so you may live!"

Moses prophesies a preferred future. God will act on our behalf.

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 "If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully keep all his commands that I am giving you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the world. You will experience all these blessings if you obey the Lord your God: Your towns and your fields will be blessed."

Deuteronomy 28:15-68 "But if you refuse to listen to the Lord your God and do not obey all the commands and decrees I am giving you today, all these curses will come and overwhelm you: Your towns and your fields will be cursed... Your life will constantly hang in the balance. You will live night and day in fear, unsure if you will survive."

"The KJV it was translated with a causative verb ('I will bring'), but it should have been translated with a permissive verb ('I will permit')"

Deuteronomy 28:61 "The Lord will afflict (Causative) you with every sickness and plague there is, even those not mentioned in this Book of Instruction, until you are destroyed." "The Lord will allow (Permissive) every..."

Galatians 3:5-6 "Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?— just as Abraham "believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness."

Galatians 3:10 "But those who depend on the law to make them right with God are <u>under his curse</u>, for the Scriptures say, 'Cursed is everyone who does not observe and <u>obey all the command</u>s that are written in God's Book of the Law." (Deut. 27:26)

Galatians 3:13-14 "Christ has <u>redeemed</u> us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), <u>that (PURPOSE CLAUSE</u>) the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, <u>that (PURPOSE CLAUSE)</u> we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."

Redeemed (exagorazō):— to recover from the power of another, of Christ freeing men from the dominion of the Mosaic law. The power of sin is the law!

Romans 4:3 "For the Scriptures tell us, 'Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." Genesis12:2-3 "I will make you into a great nation. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others."

Reformation: "...the just shall live by faith." Hab. 2:4 "...the just shall live by faith." Rom 1:17 "...the just shall live by faith." Gal. 3:11 "...the just shall live by faith." Heb. 10:38

The law says: Do this. The gospel says: Accept this. The difference between trying and trusting

Romans 7:6 "But now we have been released from the law, for we died to it and are no longer captive to its power. Now we can serve God, not in the old way of obeying the letter of the law, but in the new way of living in the Spirit."
