- 5. The cites of refuge were pre-planned, accessible, seen from a distance, had road signs, and all the people were instructed about them. What do these details show us about our place of refuge, Jesus?
- 6. How is Jesus our city of refuge? Refuge from what? And, how do we see Jesus in the death of the High Priest?
- 7. Tell us one other way that you saw Jesus in the Old Testament this week, and one question you have from the readings.
