

- b. Abundance (8) "so he will give me timber"
- c. **Angels** (9) "officers and cavalry with me."



- 2. He's At Work For You Nehemiah. 2:12-17
- a. He's at work before you call.
- "Three days later, I slipped out during the night..." (11, 12)
- b. He has a plan. "...said anything to anyone about my plans." (16)
- c. He take it personally. "...what
- trouble we are in." (17) The Jesus Trip



3. He Engages Your Faith
