1. The Fact Of Incarnation The UNOIN of Divinity with Humanity. God became flesh! Isaiah 9:6 "For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."

John1:1-3

Jesus Christ

Matthew 1:21-23
