Romans 2:4 "Do not be seized with alarm and struck with fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom!"

Luke 12:32 "Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?"

Matthew 23:13 "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in."

1 Cor. 4:20 "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power."

Luke 17:20-21 "Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; 21 nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."



Discussion Questions

- 1. When you think about the kingdom of God what comes to mind?
- 2. Read Isaiah 9:6-7 and Daniel 2:44. What do you think the Israelites thought that the Kingdom of God would look like? What about the coming king?
- 3. Why is the message of the kingdom so important? Look at Matthew 24:14, Romans 5:17, Revelation 1:4-5, and Romans 8:19 to help shape your answer.
- 4. Who is the Ruler / King of the kingdom of God? How and why is He the Ruler? How does the kingdom of God differ from democracy.
- 5. A kingdom has a realm / domain. How would you describe the realm or domain of God's kingdom. Where is it? (Rom. 14:17)
- 6. Every Kingdom has revelation; a particular culture or language. In your own words, how would you describe the culture, language, vibe of the kingdom of God.
- 7. Which of the following is the best definition of *metanoeo*?

 (a.) repent and turn from sin or (b.) in light of the good news you just heard, think differently.
- 8. Look at the verses on the front of the page about the kingdom. Go through each one at a time as a group and let everyone have a chance to share what they think each verse means and how it might speak to them.
