Ice Breaker: Tell us about some special meals that you and/or your family have had. What did you eat? What was the occasion? Who was with you?

Scriptures:

John 13:3-5 (NLT)

3 Jesus knew that the Father had given him authority over everything and that he had come from God and would return to God. 4 So he got up from the table, took off his robe, wrapped a towel around his waist, 5 and poured water into a basin. Then he began to wash the disciples' feet, drying them with the towel he had around him.

Luke 22:19-20 (NLT)

19 He took some bread and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

20 After supper he took another cup of wine and said, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood, which is poured out as a sacrifice for you."



Discussion Questions

1. If you had a couple hours one night to communicate to your closest friends just a few of your most important life lessons, what would you share and how would you do it?
2. Read John 13:3-5. What was Jesus teaching his disciples about leadership? About identity? About His Kingdom?
3. In John 13:15 Jesus said he was setting an example for his disciples. Can you think of anyone who has been an example to you in something? Why is being an example such a powerful tool for teaching and communicating?
4. Read Luke 22:19-20. What does sharing in Communion or the Lord's Supper mean to you? Share with the group.
5. What is the new commandment that Jesus gave to go along with the New Covenant? How is this different from the Old Covenant commandments?
6. Jesus said He is the way, the truth, and the life and that no one comes to the Father but through Him (John 14:6). In light of this, how would you respond to the popular statement, "there are many ways to God!"
7. Jesus said that if you have seen Him you have seen the Father (John 14:9). What can we learn about the Father through the life and person of Jesus? What does Jesus' life and ministry show us about God that we may not have seen if he had not come?
8. What are some of the things that the Holy Spirit does for us?
9. In John 17 Jesus said he was sending his disciples just as he was sent? What does that meant? Sent by whom and to do what?
