Genesis 21 "Weaning"



Genesis 21:1-12,

"So the child grew and was weaned. And Abraham made a great feast ... And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, whom she had borne to Abraham, scoffing. Therefore she said to Abraham, "Cast out this bondwoman and her son; ...shall not be heir with my son,..."
