Discussion Questions

3. Which of the 7 Principles of Overcomers (listed on the front of page) speaks the most to you right now? Share and discuss why with the group.
4. Read Luke 23:34. How does forgiveness empower you to not live a victimized life? What damage can un-forgiveness do?
5. Read John 19:28-30 and Jeremiah 31:29-31,34. What did Jesus accomplish for us here? How does this example show us that "mission helps endurance."
6. Why is the Resurrection so important to our faith and lives? How is it the "central theme of the Christian faith?"
7. Taken from John 20:1-20 and printed on the front of the page, which of the "Seven Sayings of a Risen Saviour" speak the most to you right now? Share and discuss why with the group.
8. How does the resurrection empower you for every day of your life, the good times and the bad?
9. Romans 6:5 says "*For if we have been united together in the likeness of his death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of his resurrection..,*" What does the death and the resurrection, remembered at Communion, tell you about you? How does this revelation impact your life?
