


2 Corinthians 5:17 (AMP)

engraft or ingraft

- 1. to graft (a shoot, bud, etc) onto a stock so the that the two grow together as one.
- 2. to incorporate in a firm or permanent way; implant: they engrafted their principles into the document.



For there to be a good graft you need an identical cut. Then they must be bound together to become one. There can be no grafting without wounding.
