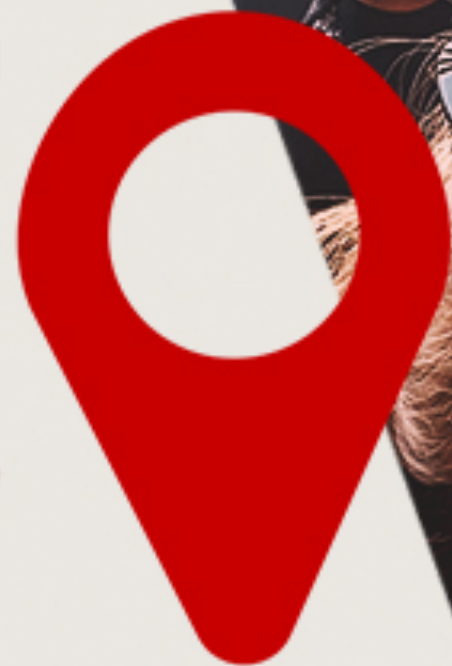

For over 75 years, Harvard's **Grant and Glueck Study** had tracked the physical and emotional well-being of two populations: 456 poor men growing up in Boston from 1939 to 2014, and 268 male graduates from Harvard's classes of 1939-1944.



**The conclusion?** Robert Waldinger, director of the Harvard Study of Adult Development:  
“The clearest message that we get from this 75-year study is this: Good relationships keep us happier and healthier. Period.”

## Ornish Lifestyle Medicine

“Love and intimacy — our ability to connect with ourselves and others, is at the root of what makes us sick and what makes us well, ... People who feel lonely and isolated have a 300-500 percent greater risk of premature death due to physical illness.”



Impact people are committed to living in authentic community.

You cannot fulfill the purpose for God outside of community.

You can know God without community and get to heaven without community, but you can't manifest God's fullness.

3. Anything is possible.

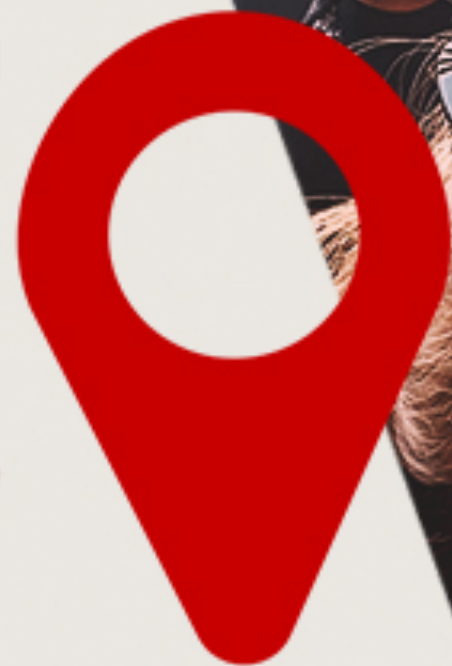
