"Love and intimacy — our ability to connect with ourselves and others, is at the root of what makes us sick and what makes us well, ... People who feel lonely and isolated have a 300-500 percent greater risk of premature death due

For over 75 years, Harvard's Grant and Glueck Study had tracked the physical and emotional well-being of two populations: 456 poor men growing up in Boston from 1939 to 2014, and 268 male graduates from Harvard's classes of 1939-1944.

## The conclusion? Robert Waldinger, director of the Harvard Study of Adult Development: "The clearest message that we get from this 75-year study is this: Good relationships keep us happier and healthier. Period."

## Healthy Relationships Happen:

- 1. When You Let Go
- "...but emptied himself,"

- Completely yielded to the Father.



#### 2. When You Go Low

"...taking the form of a <u>servant</u>," More significant than what he let go is what he became.

"And being found in <u>human</u> form" Complete Identification.



#### 3. When You Do More

- "...count others <u>more</u> significant than yourselves."
- Complete Humility.
- 1 John 3:16 "By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers."

## 4. When You Say Lord

Complete exaltation!!!

"...highly exalted Him ...and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord," Every person exposed to the PEACE of His Kingdom.
