




An interpersonal relationship is a strong, deep, or close association or acquaintance between two or more people that may range in duration from brief to enduring. This association may be based

on <u>inference</u>, <u>love</u>, <u>solidarity</u>, regular business interactions, or some other type of social commitment. Interpersonal relationships are formed in the context of social, cultural and other influences.

The context can vary

from <u>family</u> or <u>kinship</u> relations, <u>friendship</u>, <u>marriage</u>, relations with associates, <u>work</u>, <u>clubs</u>, <u>neighborhoods</u>, and <u>places of worship</u>. They may be regulated by <u>law</u>, <u>custom</u>, or mutual agreement, and are the basis of <u>social groups</u> and <u>society</u> as a whole.




