First two feasts have been fulfilled. "fully come" In one day.

- Tabernacles will be fulfilled very soon. The trumpets will sound. Jesus will return. We will forever tabernacle with the Lord. In one day.

 Pentecost Righteous Impartation
 Harvest Righteous Gathered
