Work Dissatisfaction Leads To:

- Being Disappointed
- overlooked unappreciated failed
- Being Disengaged (Gallop 2013 – 70% disengaged)
- Being Driven
- Consumed, Idolatry 86% working more than 40 hrs and taking less vacation time.

- Joseph – a career path to be avoided

Joseph's Journey Gen 37 -

48

- Promised
- Pitted
- Potted
- Prisoned
- Pardoned
- Promoted

Joseph - promised

Gen 37 - Now Israel (Jacob) loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a [distinctive] multicolored tunic. 4 His brothers saw that their father loved Joseph more than all of his brothers; so they hated him and could not [find it within themselves to] speak to him on friendly terms. 5 Now **Joseph dreamed a dream**, and he told it to his brothers, and they hated him even more.

9 But Joseph **dreamed still another dream**, and told it to his brothers [as well].

Joseph - pitted

- Gen 37 -18 And when they saw him from a distance, even before he came close to them, they plotted to kill him. 19 They said to one another, “Look, here comes this dreamer. 20 Now then, come and let us kill him and throw him into one of the pits (cisterns, underground water storage); then we will say [to our father], ‘A wild animal killed and devoured him’; and **we shall see what will become of his dreams!**”

Joseph - pitted

- 39 Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an Egyptian officer of Pharaoh, the captain of the [royal] guard, bought him from the Ishmaelites, who had taken him down there. 2 **The Lord was with Joseph, and he [even though a slave] became a successful and prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian.** 3 Now his master saw that the Lord was with him and that **the Lord caused all that he did to prosper (succeed) in his hand.** 4 So Joseph pleased Potiphar and **found favor in his sight** and he served him as his personal servant. He **made Joseph overseer over his house**, and he put all that he owned in Joseph's charge.

Joseph - potted

- Gen 39 – 17 Then she told her husband the same story, saying, “The Hebrew servant, whom you brought among us, came to me to mock and insult me; 18 then as soon as I raised my voice and screamed, he left his robe with me and ran outside [the house].”

Joseph - prisoned

- Gen 39 – 19 And when Joseph’s master heard the words of his wife, saying, “This is the way your servant treated me,” his anger burned. 20 **So Joseph’s master took him and put him in the prison,** a place where the king’s prisoners were confined; so he was there in the prison.

Joseph - prisoned

- Gen 39 – 21 But the **Lord was with Joseph** and extended lovingkindness to him, and **gave him favor** in the sight of the warden. 22 The warden committed to Joseph's care (management) all the prisoners who were in the prison; so that whatever was done there, **he was in charge of it**. 23 The warden paid no attention to anything that was in Joseph's care because the Lord was with him; **whatever Joseph did, the Lord made to prosper**.

Joseph - promoted

- Gen 41 – 12 Now there was with us [in the prison] a young man, a Hebrew, servant to the captain of the guard; and we told him, and he interpreted our dreams for us, to each man according to the significance of his own dream. 13 **And just as he interpreted [the dreams] for us, so it happened;**
- 14 Then Pharaoh sent and called for Joseph....., 15 Pharaoh said to Joseph, “I have dreamed a dream, and there is no one who can interpret it; and I have heard it said about you that you can understand a dream and interpret it.” 16 Joseph answered Pharaoh, “**It is not in me [to interpret the dream]; God [not I] will give Pharaoh a favorable answer [through me]**

Joseph - promoted

- Gen 41 – 38 So Pharaoh said to his servants, “Can we find a man like this [a man equal to Joseph], **in whom is the divine spirit [of God]?**” 39 Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, “Since [your] God has shown you all this, there is no one as discerning and clear-headed and wise as you are. 40 **You shall have charge over my house, and all my people shall be governed according to your word and pay respect** [to you with reverence, submission, and obedience]; only in [matters of] the throne will I be greater than you [in Egypt].”



- Jacob and Laban – my boss is a cheat!
- Wrong wife, no pay, no respect



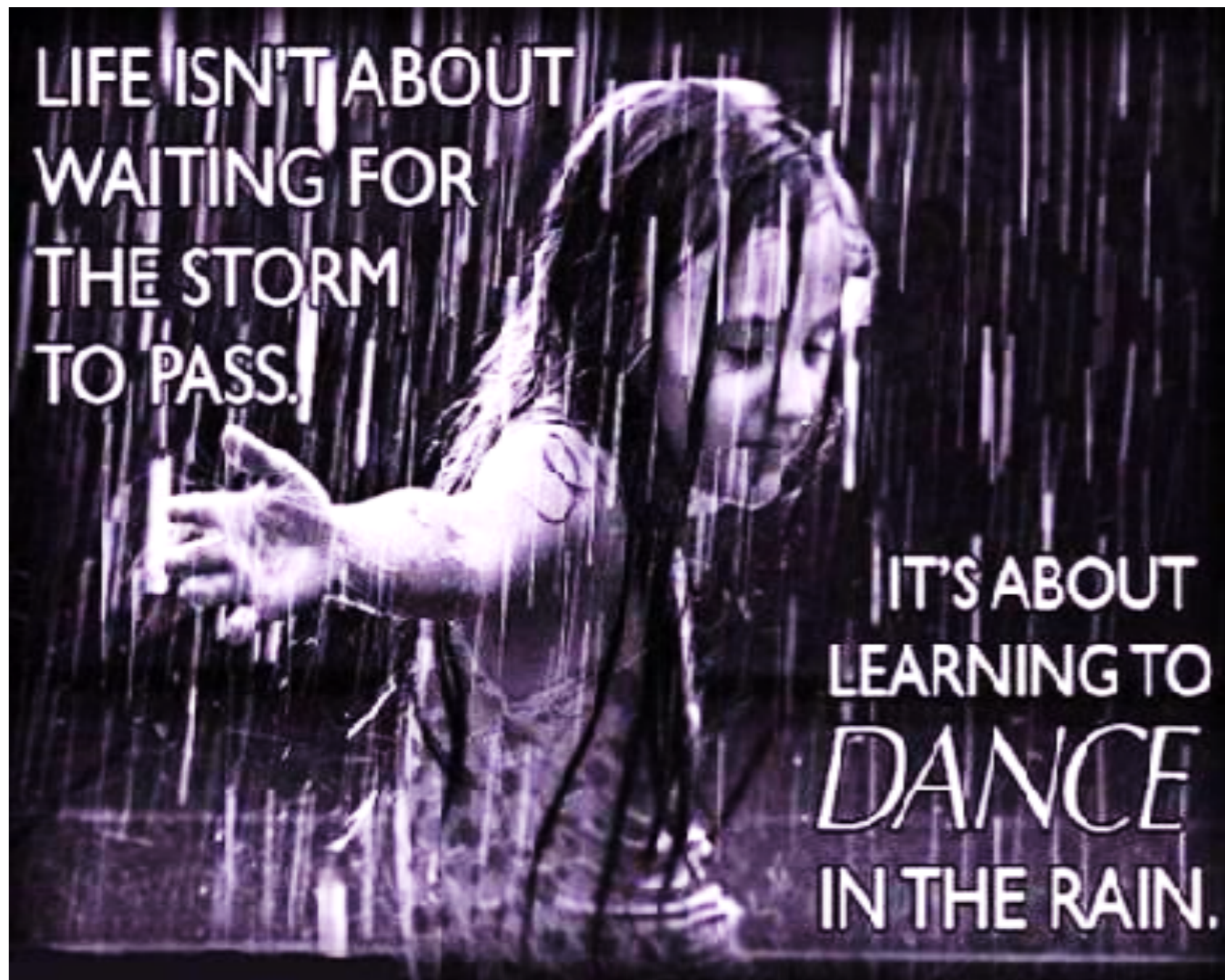
- Gen 31 -7 Yet your father has cheated me [as often as possible] and changed my wages ten times; **but God did not allow him to hurt me.** 8 If he said, ‘The speckled shall be your wages,’ then the entire flock gave birth to speckled [young]; and if he said, ‘The streaked shall be your wages,’ then the entire flock gave birth to streaked [young]. 9 **Thus God has taken away the flocks of your father and given them to me.**

How then shall you live? What will you do now?

- Wrong job, wrong career path, dishonest people, wrong background, no skills?
- God has the answer – your destiny will not be denied!
- You are destined for glory!

Be who you were called to be –

- Josh 1:9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not be terrified or dismayed (intimidated), for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” **[Boldness!]**
- Jer 1: 5 “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you [and approved of you as My chosen instrument], And before you were born I consecrated you [to Myself as My own]; I have appointed you as a prophet to the nations.” **[Gifting!]**
- Matthew 5:13-16 “**You are the salt of the earth; “You are the light of [Christ to] the world.** A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ...**[Godly influence!]**”
