Power of Words

Matthew 12: 36

I tell you, on the Day of Judgment people will give account for every careless Word they speak.

Matthew 12:37

For by your Words you will be justified, and by your Words, you will be condemned.

Ephesians 2:10

For we are his “workmanship” created in Christ Jesus unto good works....the word “workmanship “ is the Greek word poiema, which comes from the same root word as poietes.
