Another translation: There is
“no harness!”



Genesis 1:28

realizing His mandate for mankind.

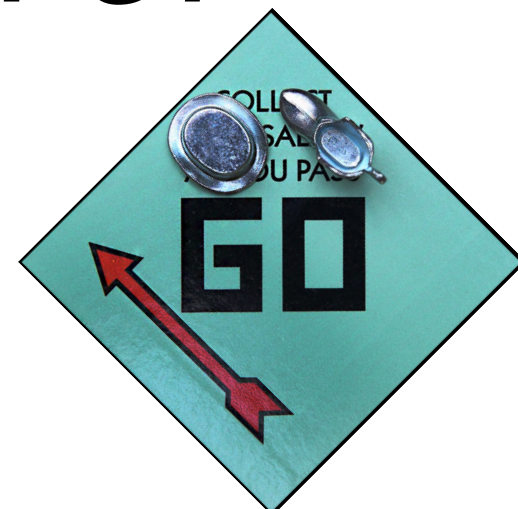
Romans 3:23 *“For all have sinned

“And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.”

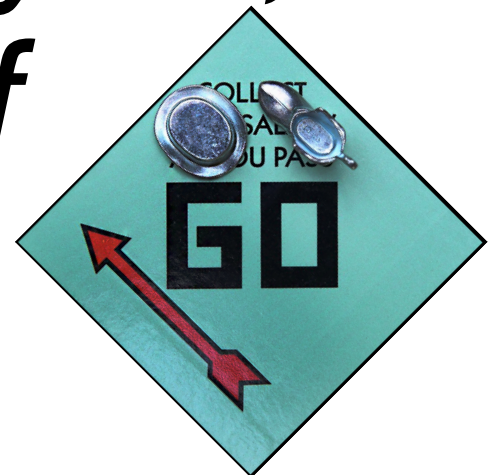


Romans 14:17

Crown (*`atar*):—to surround, to
crown, give a crown, crown-

All Authority Is Given Authority

Romans 13:1

“Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.”



Adam Was Given Authority

Genesis 1:26

“Then God said, ‘Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion’...”



Psalm 8:4-6

Ecclesiastes 10:5-7

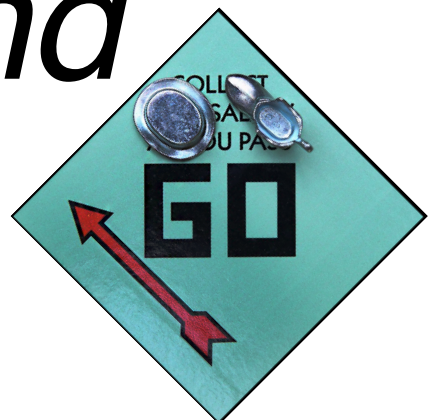
“There is an evil which I have seen under the sun,... I have seen servants upon horses, and princes walking as servants upon the earth.”

Luke 4:6-8 (NIV)

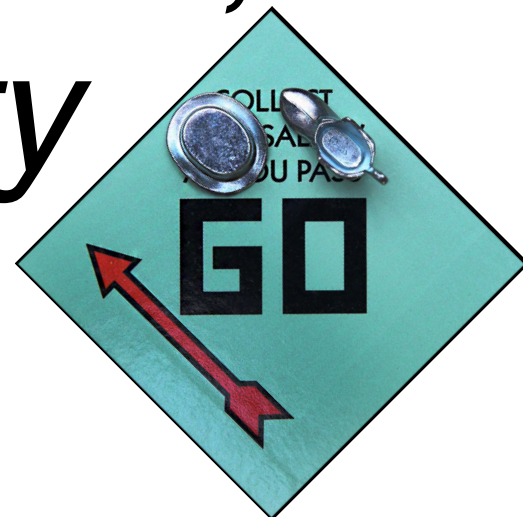

Matthew 9:6-8

John 5:27

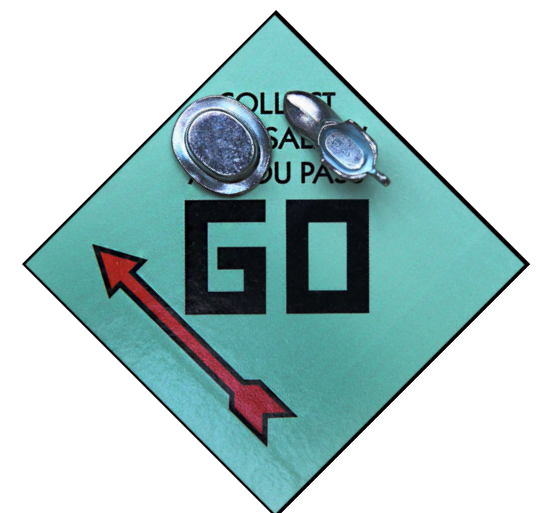
“And He has given Him authority and granted Him power to execute (exercise, practice) judgment because He is a Son of man [very man].”



Jesus Recovered All Authority

Matthew 28:18-19

“And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations,...”



John 14:12-13

“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.”

Revelation 1:5-6

“To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.”

We Are Crowned How?

Romans 5:17

“For if by the one man’s offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.”



We Are Crowned Why?

Romans 5:21

“...so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Wherever sin and death have encroached on God's eternal plan we have authority to remove it!



2 Peter 2:9

*“But you are a chosen generation,
a royal priesthood, a holy nation,
His own special people, that you
may proclaim the praises of Him
who called you out of darkness
into His marvellous light;”*
