WHAT NOT
TO WEAR

Genesis 1:28 NKJV

*“Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and **subdue it**; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”*

TLV *“Be fruitful and multiply, fill the land, and **conquer it**.”*

“Subdue” (*kabash*) :— conquer, subjugate, bring into bondage, force, keep under, subdue, bring into subjection.

Kibosh :— to eliminate, terminate

“Put the Kibosh on that!”

Genesis 2:15

“Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.”

“Keep It” **Shamar**:— to keep, guard, keep watch and ward, protect, save life and protect ...

What are they guarding against? **God’s Enemies.**



Ephesians 6:10-13

“Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities,...”

WHAT **NOT**
TO WEAR

*“...against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able **to withstand** in the evil day, and having done all, **to stand.***



wrestle:— (*pal'-ay*) a contest between two in which each endeavours to throw the other, and which is decided when the victor is able to hold his opponent down with his hand upon his neck.

Romans 16:20 *“And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly.”*

Mankind is to protect (*shamar*)
the eternal purpose of God and to
once and for all put the KIBOSH
(*kabash*) on His enemies!!!

In our contending with the devil
we have a command to **Stand**
and a command to **Wrestle**.

Ephesians 1:20-21

Ephesians 2:1-7 “And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others...”

*“**But God**, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace...”*
