

Ephesians 6:17-19

"...and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, ... and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel,..."

Luke 11:1-4

"Lord, teach us to pray, ... And He said to them, When you pray, <u>say</u>:"

Mark11:23-24 "...believes that what he <u>says</u> will take place, it will be done for him."

"say" (*lego*):-- to speak, to command, to direct, to point out with words.

Matthew 4:4 "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds (rhema) from the mouth of God." Luke 1:37-38 "For with God nothing (no rhema) will be impossible... Let it be to me according to your word. (rhema)

Hebrews 4:12 "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." Two-edged (Distomos):— two mouthes

Isaiah 55:11

"So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not <u>return</u> to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it."



Jeremiah 1:9-10

"Then the Lord put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the Lord said to me: 'Behold, I have put My words in your mouth. See, I have this day set you over the nations and over the kingdoms, To root out and to pull down, To destroy and to throw down, To build and to plant."

Jeremiah 1:12 (AMP)

"Then said the Lord to me, You have seen well, for I am alert and active, watching over My word to perform it."
