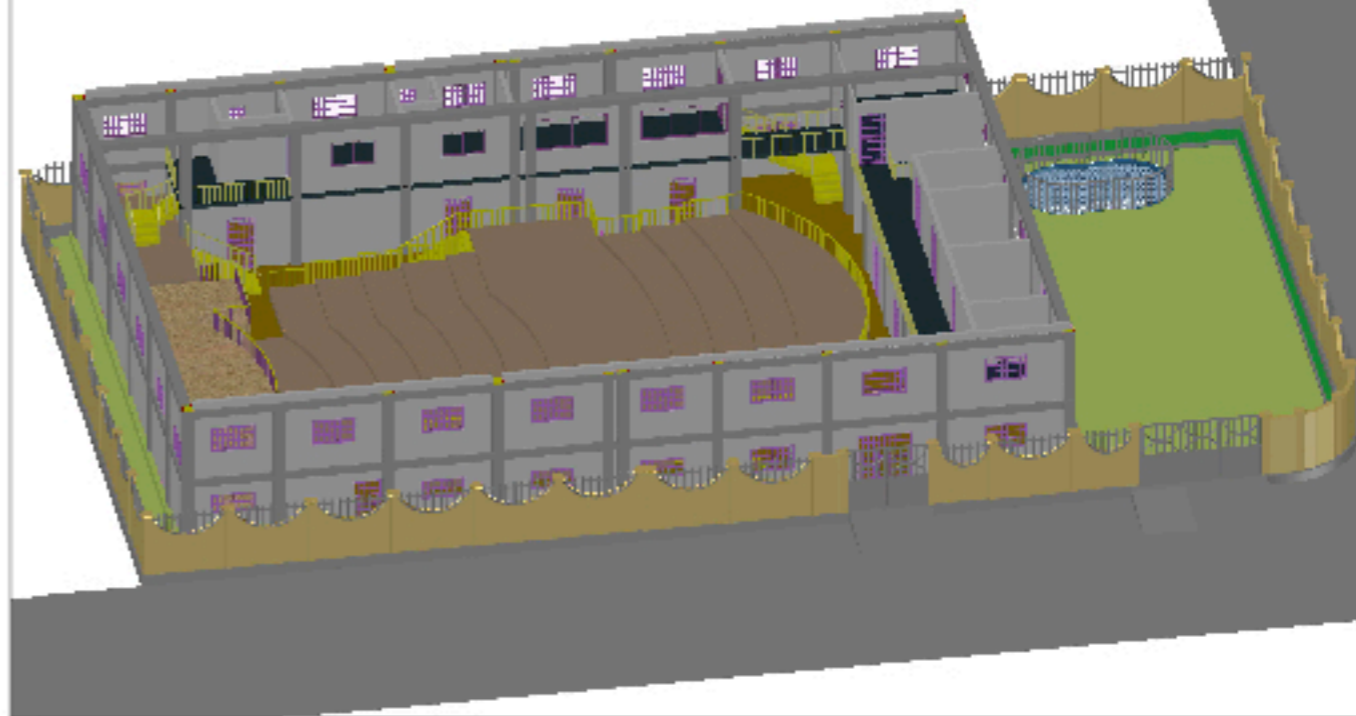

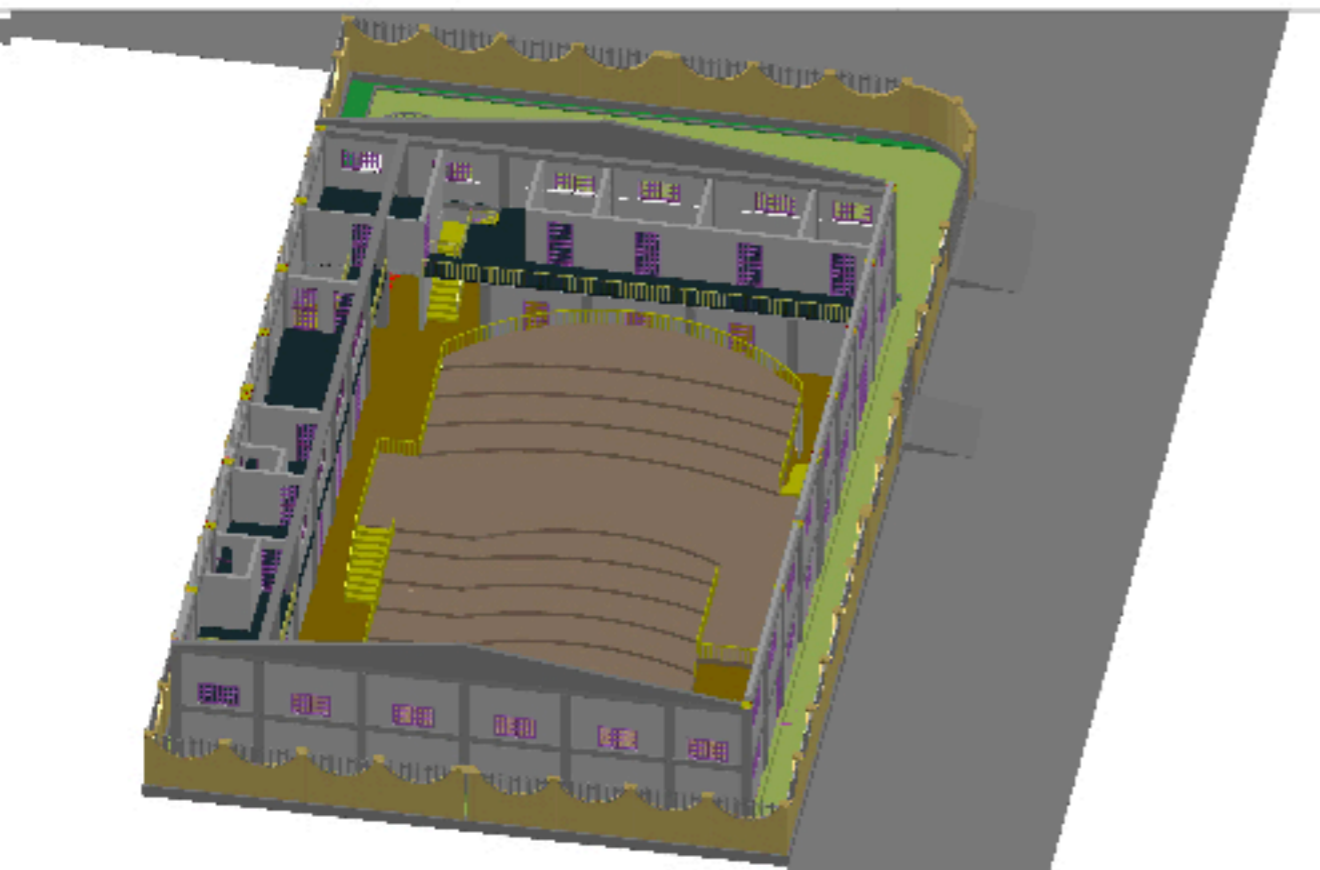




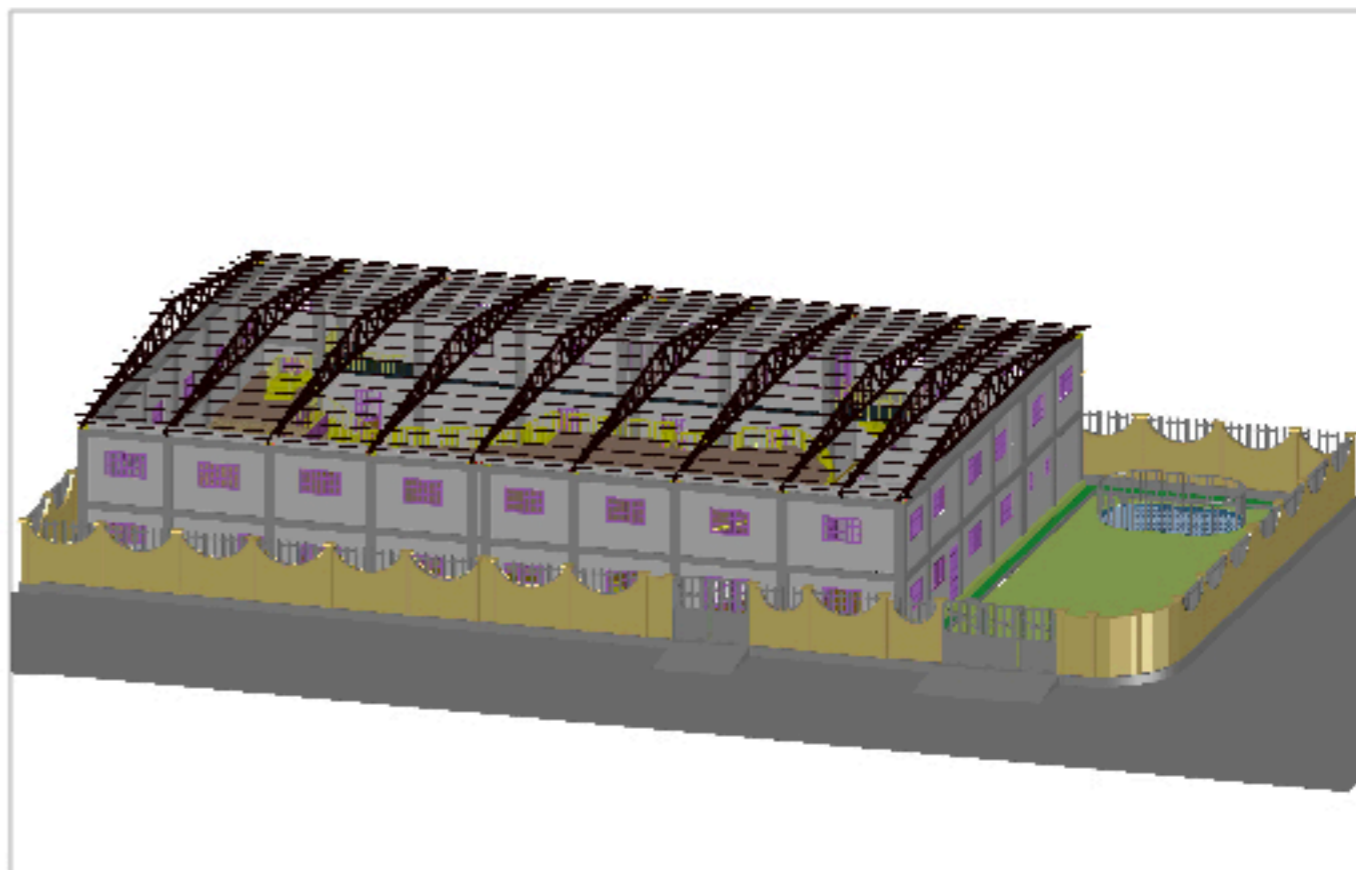

Wrong Timing Wrong Instrument

Exodus 2:11-12

“And he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. So he looked this way and that way, and when he saw no one, he killed the Egyptian and hid him in the sand.”

40 years in the desert!

Exodus 3:1-4

*“Now Moses was tending the flock ...
And the Angel of the Lord appeared

midst of a bush. ‘I will now turn
aside and see this great sight,’ ... So
when the Lord saw that he turned
aside to look, God called to him from
the midst of the bush and said,
‘Moses, Moses!’”*

Exodus 3 - 4:20

“Who am I that I should go...”

“What shall I say to them?”

“What If they don’t believe Me?”

“I am not eloquent,...”

“Please send someone else.”

“What is that in your hand?”

“And Moses took the rod of God in his hand.”

God gave Moses Many “I will’s”:

I will be with you. Vs.12

I will bring you out. Vs. 17

I will stretch out my hand. Vs .20

I will give favour. Vs. 21
