



Psychology Today, June 21,2011 "Laughter reduces levels of stress hormones such as cortisol, epinephrine, and dopamine; increases health-enhancing hormones (such as endorphins), neurotransmitters, and infectionfighting antibodies; ...

... and improves blood flow to the heart—all resulting in greater relaxation and resistance to disease, as well as improved mood and positive outlook."



Laugh:— the chuckle, the titter, the giggle, the chortle, the cackle, the belly laugh, the sputtering burst, snicker, snigger, guffaw, the snort.

Laughter can be, joyous, happy, nervous, paradoxical, courtesy laugh, evil laughter.

Study of laughter is called **Gelotology**.

Laugh structure or anatomy: A normal laugh has the structure of "ha-ha-ha" or "ho-ho-ho." It is unnatural, and one is physically unable, to have a laugh structure of "ha-ho-ha-ho."
