He was in the world..."






# 1 John 1:8

GRACE is the solution.



"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."



#### 2 Words for Forgiveness

Two Greek words are used to translate the word "forgive." The first is **charizomai**, from the word **charis**, which means "grace." It means "to bestow a favor unconditionally; to show one's self gracious, kind, benevolent; or to grant forgiveness, to pardon.

By contrast, our word, aphiemi, means "to send away."



# <u>Confess:</u> Strong's # 3670 homologéō - ὁμολογέω

(from 3674 /homoú, "together" and 3004 /légō, "speak to a conclusion") properly, to voice the same conclusion, i.e. agree ("confess"); to profess (confess) because in full agreement; to align with (endorse).

### 1 John 2:1-2


"My little children, these things I write to you that you may not sin. And if anyone does sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He Himself is the propitiation [atoning sacrifice] for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world."

Advocate - παράκλητον (parakletos) Strong's #3875.

Legal advocate, like a lawyer, OR "comforter" or "helper."

With - πρός (pros) Strong's #4314. "Moving toward a destination."

He helps move me toward the Father!



# Who is our advocate, helper comforter?

"He is Himself the atoning sacrifice for ours sin, and not only ours but for the sins of whole world."


